Under the Provisions of the Environmental Management Act

ENVIROGREEN TECHNOLOGIES LTD.

is authorized to discharge emissions to the air from a thermal treatment facility located at Similco Mines Ltd, British Columbia, subject to the terms and conditions listed below. Contravention of any of these conditions is a violation of the Environmental Management Act and may lead to prosecution.

This Permit supersedes and cancels all previous versions of Permit 13075 issued under Part 2, Section 14 of the Environmental Management Act.

1. AUTHORIZED DISCHARGES

- 1.1 This subsection applies to the **storage** of hazardous waste. The site reference number for this discharge is E231534.
- 1.1.1 The maximum quantity of hazardous waste to be stored on site is 50,000 tonnes.
- 1.1.2 The characteristics of the material to be stored are:
 - 1. hydrocarbon contaminated soil;
 - 2. hydrocarbon hazardous waste soil;
 - 3. spent activated carbon;
 - 4. waste petroleum tank bottoms solids;
 - 5. waste oily rags, and;
 - 6. other wastes and hazardous wastes, which the Director may authorize, in writing, from time to time, in keeping with the intent of this permit, provided that such authorization does not constitute a significant amendment to the permit.
