The Industrial Electrician works under the direction of the Plant Supervisor and any assigned Supervisors and works with other employees within the company to ensure safe work practices and policies, compliances and regulations are adhered.

The Industrial Electrician will perform and document the installation, assembly, repair, and preventative maintenance on our electrical components in an industrial setting in accordance with regulations, codes, permits, approved drawings and specifications. This position also requires the Industrial Electrician to maintain, test, troubleshoot, service and repair industrial electrical equipment, such as motors, generators, pumps and lighting systems and associated electrical controls. Other responsibilities involve physical labour at the Work Site.

The Industrial Electrician will work closely with facility staff to create a positive and safe working environment, be a resource to management and facility staff for health and safety information and promote health and safety programs in the workplace.

Requirements

- Industrial Electrician Red Seal designation.
- Minimum Education: High School or equivalent.
- Certification as an FSR (Field Safety Representative) would be an asset.
- Minimum 5 years Industrial Electrician experience.
- Basic understanding of office computer software and systems.
- Licence: Valid Class 5 driver's licence and access to reliable transportation.



Core Job Duties

- Perform and document the installation, assembly, repair, and preventative maintenance on our electrical components in an industrial setting in accordance with regulations, codes, permits, approved drawings and specifications.
- Troubleshoot and diagnose and repair equipment or components directly or indirectly exposed to electrical power such as motors, generators, pumps and lighting systems.
- Follow running and shutdown instructions.
- Perform mechanical, electrical and all other energy-source disconnects when required for lock out or facility repair.
- Diagnose, locate the cause of, and repair malfunctioning systems and components using test equipment.
- Maintain electrical workshop and storage facilities in a clean, organized and safe manner.
- Maintain an accurate equipment service, maintenance, and repair record.
- Ensure all work performed adheres to all relevant organizational, provincial, and federal safety regulations, codes and specifications.
- Responsible for tool inventory.
- Liaise with suppliers and outside contractors for major repairs or upgrades.
- Maintain facility analyzers and report deficiencies.
- Maintain water treatment facility and report deficiencies.
- Maintain all related site electrical devices from 300HP motors to 120V receptacles.
- Maintain facility transformer room in a clean and safe condition.
- Assist in design and upgrades of new or replacement equipment.
- Maintain a recorded inventory of consumable electrical parts for facility operation.
- Participate in facility upgrade planning.
