- Cleans and stocks restroom facilities.
- Cleans light fixtures and changes bulbs/tubes.
- Performs minor repairs on windows, doors, desks, tables, small tools and equipment, appliances, sinks, toilets, blinds etc.
- Performs monthly fire extinguisher inspections.
- Prepares and sets up rooms for meetings, parties, or various other activities and cleans up afterwards.
- Maintains outside grounds (removes snow, ice, and debris, sprays and removes weeds, sweeps and cleans gutters).
- General labour duties as required.
- Participate in required training programs including, but not limited to, WHMIS, TDG, confined space entry and rescue, fall protection, fire extinguisher use, first aid, mobile equipment awareness, aerial work platform, etc.
